- 1. What are Dodo and Coco?
  - They are clones of Eric's former dogs.
- 2. What do animal rights campaigners think of commercial cloning?

  They think it's harmful and unethical it's tinkering with genetic material in the hope of making a lot of money at a great ethical expense.
- 3. Who are most of the customers at SinoGene? **Grieving cat and dog owners.**
- 4. How much does it cost to have your pet cloned?

  Pet owners pay £40,000 for an almost identical companion.

  While the clones look the same, their personalities often differ.
