Grieving cat and dog owners.
4. How much does it cost to have your pet cloned?

5. Are the cloned copies identical in both looks and character?
While the clones look the same, their personalities often differ.
6. What is Jucy?
It's one of China's most famous film dogs, cloned in order to continue being used in films.
7. Which animals will be cloned next?
Horses.
